PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY

SPARTAN SPROUTS SOCCER CAMP is for boys and girls ages 5 - 9. It is specifically geared toward the young developing player and also for a player that might be taking up the sport for the first time. SSSC focuses on individual and team development. Each day, campers go through a series of skill stations designed to help them improve fundamental skills. In addition, campers are placed on teams in order to teach the foundations of working within a team and understanding what it means to be a member of a team. Each day includes individual training, small sided games, team building competitions and soccer related games.
